K-2 Report

Dear Families

A big welcome to our students and their families for 2023! I am so excited to start my teaching journey here at Morven State School. We welcome our new Kindy's to school and it has been wonderful to see the returning students help them all settle into school.

This year's Kindy's are a fun, energetic group who have loved exploring both their new indoor and outdoor environment. With the help of the P-2's they are settling in nicely to classroom activities, they loved working with the other students in STEM to make Earthquake proof buildings with playdough and sticks.

In our classroom this term, our focus in English is looking at stories from different perspectives. We will explore the text "The Lorax," for our English Assessments, as well as other fun texts like "Pig the Pug," and "I want an Iguana". We will also look at using nouns, adjectives, and verbs appropriately in our writing when exploring other characters different perspectives.

For Mathematics we will be focusing on numbers and place values. Through using concrete materials, students will work on their counting in 1's, 2's, 5's, 10s, and their number recognition.

Kindy Report

This week Morven State School Kindergarten welcomed 7 new students for 2023. A warm welcome to Dougie, Isla, Henry, Wyatt, Maybel, Clyde, Matilda and their families, to our school community. We will also welcome Luke and his family in week 2, bringing our Kindy team to 8.

As this is a new environment for them all, it was important for our Kindy team to become familiar and confident with the teaching staff and their new surroundings, whilst building their knowledge on important routines at school. For example, using the bathroom, how to use the stairs safely, how to move around the school safely on concreted area's and where their belongings are kept.

We began the week by joining our P-2 class on the carpet where our new K-2 teacher Miss Edson, lead all the students through a 'get to know you' game, where when the ball was rolled to each student they were able to share their favourite activity that they enjoy doing at home. With the lure of the Activity room calling, we went into our newly renovated space and explored what is in there.

We also began our journey of building other important skills such as sharing, turn taking, taking care of our belongings and showing kindness to each other in that space. We have seen some beautiful examples already.

On Tuesday, we were able to begin our day with a story, a routine that we will do each day. We have dabbled in some other routines that will also become part of usual day at Kindy. This includes, joining our P-2 classmates for certain activities. On Tuesday afternoon, we joined them for a 'STEM' activity (STEM = Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths). The P-2 class explored earthquakes, and were tasked with creating a building from playdough and sticks that could withstand a little shake of the table as a simulated earthquake. The P-2 class all chose a Kindy team mate to work with them and help to build their playdough and stick house, which they all enjoyed. The buildings were great and it was positive to see our P-2 class embrace their new Kindy mates throughout the activity.
